Correspondence:

The following correspondence was highlighted by President Gwaltney:

- Betty Fox Reminded us that delegate forms should be sent the ADAA Central Office by January 31,2017. Expressed her appreciation for 4th District's support during her time in office as 4th District Trustee. She is considering submitting her name for ADAA Secretary and asked for our support. We also discussed finding an accountant who can proceed with the Audit of NCDAA finances, with Dan Hill no longer able to do this. We appreciate so much the services Dan has provided these many years. Linda Clark had met with Nanette and brought the books to this meeting. Joyce Baker has talked with an accountant in Conover, N. C, Tim S. Barringer, and he has agreed to audit the financial books of NCDAA.

Linda Clark moved that we secure Tim Barringer to Audit the NCDAA Treasurer's books. Kristy Eddleman second. Motion Carried. President Gwaltney asked Joyce Baker to take the books to Mr. Barringer.

Standing Committee Reports:

Judicial/Legislative: Deana Billings sent a report stating that the Certified Press of the DANB, Fall 2016, reported that the NC State Board of Dental Examiners adopted a series of rule amendments that:

- 1.Require all DA I and DA II dental assistants be current CPR certified.
- 2. Must complete training required by statute to perform radiography procedures.
- 3. Modified the language related to impressions.
- 4. Made other minor changes and corrections.

She will be getting further clarification on some of these changes and let us know at the next meeting. She also reported that there is a huge back log presently with providers being able to secure a Medicaid ID, at least 3 to 4 months.

ByLaws/Manual Of Procedures: Nanette Hill - No Report at this time. We were made aware that ADAA will be making changes during Annual Session and we will need to be in compliance following the Annual Session, **Membership:** Vicky Wesner - President Gwaltney gave a report in the absence of Vicky.

Budget & Finance: Nanette Hill - No Report


