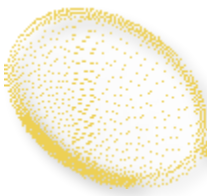


From the Desk of the NCDAA President:

Please remind the student members in your local society to apply for the scholarship awards given each year. Their instructors should have the information.

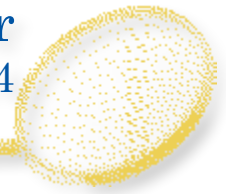

NCDAА ANNUAL SESSION AWARDS

THE EDNA ZEDAKER LOYAL ASSISTANT AWARD, sponsored by the Past President's Council, will be presented to the member of NCDAА who submits the longest record of consecutive employment, with one employer, provided she/he has not previously received the award. (The term of consecutive employment shall refer to an assistant actually employed by, but not married to her employer). A notarized statement giving the date of original employment and stating that she/he has been a member of NCDAА for at least 2 years must be signed by her employer and the President and Secretary of her local society. It must be 2 consecutive years just prior to application of the award, that he or she has been a member of NCDAА. The recipient of this award does not have to be present at Annual Session to receive this award.

THE WILLIAM H. OLIVER ACHIEVEMENT AWARD, sponsored by Linda W. Clark, will be presented to the member, who in the opinion of the Executive Board has done the most outstanding work for NCDAА and for dental assistants.

THE ETHEL EARL ACHIEVEMENT AWARD, sponsored by the family of Faye J. Watkins, will be presented to a member of NCDAА, not currently serving on the Executive Committee, who in the opinion of the Executive Board has done the most outstanding work for the Association and for dental assistants.

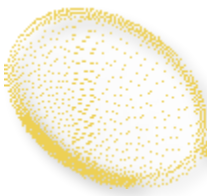
NCDAА VOLUNTEERISM AWARD, sponsored by Carolyn C. Newman, will be presented to a local society or active membership status individual for recognition of volunteer service to underserved populations for clinical, educational, or monetary support. This work is performed in the local community, state, or international levels of service.

NCDAА LOCAL SOCIETY EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM AWARD will be presented to the local society submitting the best educational program for at least six regular meetings of the current year.

THE EDNA ZEDAKER SCHOLARSHIP of \$250 will be presented to a student enrolled in an accredited Dental Assisting Program. The selection will be made by the Scholarship Committee.

THE FAYE J. WATKINS, CDA, SCHOLARSHIP OF MERIT, sponsored by NCDAА, will be presented to a student member of NCDAА who attends an accredited Dental Assisting School in the state of North Carolina. The student must exhibit professionalism, leadership qualities, a commitment to the profession of Dental Assisting and a commitment to community service.

THE HARRY LEMMONS MEMBERSHIP AWARD will be presented to the local society with the second largest percentage of increase in active membership since the close of last Annual Session of NCDAА.



NCDAА LOCAL SOCIETY EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM AWARD will be presented to the local society submitting the best educational program for at least six regular meetings of the current year.

THE EDNA ZEDAKER SCHOLARSHIP of \$100 will be presented to a student enrolled in a Dental Assisting Program. The selection will be made by the Scholarship Committee.

THE FAYE J. WATKINS, CDA, SCHOLARSHIP OF MERIT, sponsored by NCDAА, will be presented to a student member of NCDAА who attends an accredited Dental Assisting School in the state of North Carolina. The student must exhibit professionalism, leadership qualities, a commitment to the profession of Dental Assisting and a commitment to community service.

NCDAА - Edna Zedaker Scholarship Award

The Edna Zedaker Scholarship Award is a monetary award based on need and academic achievement. All Students in Dental Assisting Schools in North Carolina are eligible to apply.

Edna was a Certified Dental Assistant in Charlotte, NC. She worked with Dr. Burt Fox for her entire career. She was a Past-President of the American Dental Assistants Association and a Past President of the North Carolina Dental Assistants Association. NCDA Executive Board Meeting

November 5, 2013
Rita Millikan, CDA, President, Presiding

President Rita Millikan called the Executive Board of NCDA to order at 1:35pm. Secretary Dianne Gwaltney called the roll and a quorum was present in order to conduct business of the association. Current correspondence was shared with the association.

Treasurer Kristy Eddleman reported that we currently have a balance of \$ 4761.28 in our checking account and \$2411.81 in our savings account. The Edna Zedaker Scholarship account balance is \$895.80 and the Faye Watkins Scholarship account balance is \$1304.26. Kristy reported that we did not need to transfer the \$1000 from our savings account to checking. There were no questions concerning the report; the report will be placed on file for audit.

Minutes from the August 16, 2013 meeting were emailed to all officers/advisor prior to today's meeting. These minutes were not read today. Minutes were approved as presented.

President Millikan presented her report to the Executive Board from the ADA Annual Session in New Orleans, Louisiana, which was held Oct. 31-Nov. 2, 2013. We have 6 delegates to attend from NC. Highlights of the Annual Session was the installation of our new president, Lori Paschal from SC. We also have a new trustee, Betty Gail Fox, from Tennessee.

Doris Clapp from Membership reported 239 active members, 307 e-members, and 270 student members as of Sept. 2013.

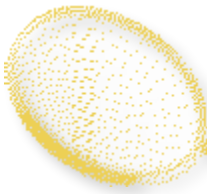
Linda Kamp and Deana Billings from Education reported that \$600 was taken in today for the CE. \$100 was given to the speaker and \$31.83 was spent on snacks, leaving a profit of \$468.17.

NCDA officers had met at Kristy's lake home outside of Salisbury the weekend of 9/28/13 and spent many hours going through and making changes and updating our Manual of Procedures/Bylaws. Nanette was able to get someone to type this revision up for us.

There were no reports from Budget/Finance or Judicial/Legislative.

The Web Committee posted today's meeting on the NCDA website and emailed members with the information. The Education Session was posted on NCDA's Facebook Page several times. The website has been renewed for another year. There were no other reports from any of the Special Committees. There was a decision by the Board to drop our support of the NC Dental Foundation. We have not had any representation on this foundation for several years. It applies more to UNC graduates.

Nanette Hill did report that NC MOM's has a new director, Dr. Donigan from Gastonia. She also reported that only 2 MOM's Projects are scheduled for 2014, one in Charlotte in February, for children. 6 of our officers served as volunteers at the MOM's clinic in Salisbury on Friday, Sept. 27.

Under new business, Joyce Baker made a motion to move the \$2411.81 from our savings account to our checking account and close out the savings account. Rationale: The amount in our savings account is gaining only 6 cent per month and we can use this amount to cushion our checking account to avoid a service charge. The motion was 2nd by Nanette Hill. Motion carried. President Rita appointed Dan Hill as our auditor. There was also much discussion to change our schedule for our state meeting. Instead of asking guests to come and give greetings at our meeting, we will invite them to our luncheon in the Officers suite.

Our next NCDAA Board meeting is scheduled for Feb. 28, 2014, at Rowan Cabarrus Community College, Salisbury Campus. Our CE will be from 9:00-12:00, our Executive Committee meeting from 12:00-1:30, and our Executive Board meeting from 1:30-4:00. MIRROR deadline was set for March 15, 2014. 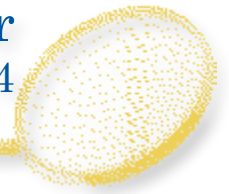

Our next meeting was in February with Robert Lawing “Doctor Shopping for Drugs.”

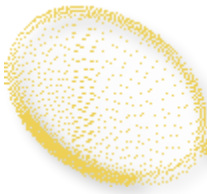
In March the speaker was Dr. J.R. Corcoran, DDS on “Dental Trauma”
